The regularly scheduled meeting of the North Lebanon Township Board of Supervisors was held at 7:00 PM at the Municipal Building located at 725 Kimmerlings Road, Lebanon, PA with the following people present:

PRESENTATION OF CHECK FROM REPRESENTATIVE PETE ZUG

Representative Pete Zug was in attendance to present a grant check to the Twp in the amount of \$10,000. The check was grant funds, which the Twp Parks & Rec had applied for in order to create a walking path located at the N 8th Avenue sporting area owned by the Twp. This walking path will make the area more accessible to handicapped individuals as well as anyone else who is utilizing the area. Rep Zug expressed his appreciation to the Twp for continuing its effort to provide sporting and recreational areas for the public. The Board accepted the check and thanking Rep Zug for his help in obtaining the grant money through DCED.

COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

There were no comments this evening from the public.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Action on the minutes from April 17, 2006 was tabled until the next meeting.

APPROVAL PAYROLL, PAYMENT OF INVOICES, FUND BALANCES

MOTION was made and seconded to approve payroll, invoices for payment subject to audit. Unanimously carried.

TOWNSHIP MANAGERS REPORT – Cheri F. Grumbine

A.)Authorization to Bid Walking Trail

With receipt of the \$10,000 grant through Rep Pete Zug, the Board is now being asked to authorize advertising the bidding for completion of the proposed walking trail from the N 8th Ave parking lot to the fields. The costs would be paid for from the grant money and Fees in Lieu of collected from developers. Some discussion was held about the sketch that had been provided to the Supervisors. Chp Hawkins asked if this is the exact design or would the design be revised. Mgr Grumbine stated that the sketch is an approximate idea of how the pathway could be completed. It is possible there might have to be revisions as the project moves along. Suv Brensinger suggested the walking path to N 8th Avenue be lined up with Woodridge Court if possible.

MOTION was made and seconded to authorize advertising for the bidding of the walking path located at the N 8th Ave fields. Unanimously carried.

B.)Update On Tire Collection Program

A report from Phil Hall was received outlining the results of the recent tire collection. NL Twp had a total of 32 residents that had participated in the collection. A total of 411 tires were reported for NLT. However review of the customer list revealed at least 3 non-residents of NLT and the invoice total will have to be adjusted. There is a possibility that some of NLT residents were logged on other municipality's reports. Phil Hall has indicated that everything should be properly adjusted by May 5. Some discussion was held about the numbers on the provided report. The Supervisors expressed their appreciation for this service that they agree is worth contributing toward.

COMMENTS FROM BOARD MEMBERS**A.)Suv Ken Artz**

Suv Artz commented on holding the first meeting in the new Meeting Room and the pleasant appearance of the new addition.

B.)Suv Ed Brensinger

Suv Brensinger also added his comments on the new area stating that the area is also larger for the meetings when the additional seating space is required. The new sound system is good to have, as now it is a lot easier to hear the conversations.

As there was no more business to conduct or discuss the meeting adjourned.
