

**MINUTES
NORTH LEBANON TOWNSHIP
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
NOVEMBER 6, 2006**

The regularly scheduled meeting of the North Lebanon Township Board of Supervisors was held at 7:00 PM at the Municipal Building located at 725 Kimmerlings Road, Lebanon, PA with the following people present:

COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

A.)Bruce Sattazahn – Maple Street

Mr. Sattazahn told the Board he wanted to express his appreciation to whomever is responsible for posting the larger visible signage for Valspar in the Tunnel Hill Rd and 22nd Street area. He stated he is not dealing with near the number of tractor-trailers he had been. His only suggestion was to contact the people at 25th Street and Tunnel Hill Rd. He had heard that there are still a lot of problems with trucks getting caught in that area. Suv Brensinger told Sattazahn the Business Park had provided the signs and the Twp posted them. Sattazahn repeated the new postings have really helped.

B.)Charles Allwein –Martin Drive

Mr. Allwein questioned when the preliminary 2007 budget would be ready for review. He was told probably at the next meeting, as the Budget should be adopted at the December meeting.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

MOTION was made and seconded to approve the minutes from the October 16, 2006. Unanimously carried.

APPROVAL PAYROLL, PAYMENT OF INVOICES, FUND BALANCES

MOTION was made and seconded to approve payroll, invoices for payment subject to audit. Unanimously carried.

TOWNSHIP MANAGERS REPORT – Read by Chp Dawn Hawkins

A.)Lebanon County Community Development Program

Information has been received in regarding the Grant funding available, through the County, for specific Development projects. The Supervisors are being asked to review the topics specified and think about projects the Township could complete with this State Grant money. Suv Artz stated the Twp has used this funding in the past. However one of the negatives with this type of funding is that certain personal information is sometimes requested and our residents resent that fact. The Supervisors agreed to take a serious look at the information provided.

B.)Proposed 2007 Meeting Dates

A tentative list of proposed meeting dates for all the Boards and Commissions has been provided to the Board for review and action. The Board members discussed some of the listed dates and felt that the dates were all acceptable. A question about the one meeting date for the Planning

Commission was asked. The 2007 November meeting is scheduled for the day the Twp employees would be scheduled to have the day off for Veterans Day. The Board decided that since this is just a tentative list they would approve the list. The Planning Commission would be asked their opinion about that one meeting in November.

Proposed 2007 Meeting Dates (con't)

MOTION was made and seconded to approve the tentative list for the 2007 meeting dates. Unanimously carried.

C.)Agreement with Humane Society

The Humane Society agreement was discussed again. Chief Easter had provided information, which the Police Dept had received via faxes. The information quoted on the agreement from the Humane Society does not agree with the information provided by the Chief. A lengthy conversation followed about the differences quoted. Suv Artz suggested offering a one-time lump sum amount to the Society. Suv Hawkins said she is concerned about the procedures for the dog impound and the release of the dogs that are collected by their owners. She said she would like to know more about the process that goes into the dog collections and the releasing of dogs to the owners. It seems like the Society is collecting fees twice. After some discussion it was decided to table this issue and request that someone from the Humane Society attend the next meeting and provide the Board with some answers to their questions.

COMMENTS FROM BOARD MEMBERS

All the Board members encouraged everyone present to exercise their right to vote and go to the polls tomorrow to vote.

As there was no more business to conduct or discuss the meeting adjourned.
