

**MINUTES

The regularly scheduled meeting of the North Lebanon Township Board of Supervisors was held at 7:00 PM at the Municipal Building located at 725 Kimmerlings Road, Lebanon, PA with the following people present:

COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

A.)Union Canal Dedication Ceremony

Glen Kreiser presented an open invitation to the public. The time of the opening ceremony is on Saturday September 9, 2006 from 10:30 AM to 4:00 PM.

Mr. Kreiser stated it has been a long time since he has been at this building. He reported he had stopped one evening at midnight and tried to ring the bell to gain entrance into the building and no one responded to the bell. Chp Hawkins stated there was probably no one in the building to respond at midnight. He disagreed saying there was an Officer here. He found an unlocked garage door and gained entrance through the garage door. Kreiser said he wanted to alert them to a woman walking down 7th St at midnight. Kresier told the Board he was disturbed that the Officer was in the building but did not respond to the doorbell when he had rung it. Mgr Grumbine said she is not sure the bell rings in the garage. Suv Brensinger said there was a sign listing phone numbers to call for contacting an Officer after normal office hours. Mr. Kresier repeated his concern that the public is coming here for help and the Officers are not responding to their appeal for help. Suv Brensinger said a discussion would be had with the Chief to find out how these types of situations are being handled by the department.

APPROVAL PAYROLL, PAYMENT OF INVOICES, FUND BALANCES

MOTION was made and seconded to approve payroll, invoices for payment subject to audit. Unanimously carried.

TOWNSHIP MANAGERS REPORT – Cheri F. Grumbine

A.)Fall Newsletter – Sept 6 Merchandiser Edition

Mgr Grumbine announced the Fall Newsletter and the Leaf Flyer will be distributed with the September 6 issue of the Merchandiser. B.)Contract w/DCED on \$5000 Grant

The written contract with DCED regarding the previously approved \$5000 grant to be used towards the generator for the Twp building has been received. The Board is being asked to approve the Chairperson and Secretary signatures on the contract and requisition for payment.

MOTION was made and seconded to execute the agreement with DCED for the proceeding of the grant money for the generator. Unanimously carried.

C.)Met Ed Luminaries

The Twp has received notification from Met Ed that they will be replacing the faulty mercury vapor luminaries with high-pressure sodium-vapor luminaries. According to costs supplied from Met Ed this change will benefit the Twp per month financially. The changes will be on all Met Ed owned luminaries on wood distribution poles with an overhead feed. Chp Hawkins questioned if the looks of the light will be changed. Mgr Grumbine replied it would appear more yellow than before.

COMMENTS FROM BOARD MEMBERS**A.)Suv Ed Brensinger - Committee Appointment**

Suv Brensinger announced he received a letter from PSATS informing him he has been chosen for an appointment to the Townships over 10,000 Committee for a 3-year term. Ed explained it is always a good thing to be connected to a PSATS committee as it allows the Twp to be up on all the current happenings.

B.)Suv Hawkins

Dawn stated that Ken Artz is not present due to his attendance in Washington D.C. this week for the Convention of the Twp Supervisors. She looks forward to his report on the activities.
