**NEW BUSINESS**

**Lenni Lenape Park**

Sheila stated she had been speaking with Earl Meyer from Lebanon County Planning Department and Lori Kieffer Yeich from DCNR regarding the design of the new Lenni Lenape Park. She stated they were putting prices together for the lineal footage and also to do the grant. She stated the project would include doing the main drive off of Narrows Drive, the walking path, pavilion, playground, bathrooms, and possibly getting the tree dedication going to generate income. She stated she also received a phone call from Rettew that they were going to do a publicity article about our park.

**Ice Cream Shop**

Sheila stated the Township and Solicitor had been working on issues with the ice cream shop. She stated there were outstanding problems regarding bills with the previous owner of the ice cream shop. She stated she had received no response from any of the correspondence that was sent.

The topic of the golf cart which was purchased for Lions Lake was raised. Sheila stated they were getting two carts. It was discussed that it would be more efficient and less costly than using the service truck.

Sheila stated she had mailed out the athletic agreements on January 10, 2008. They went to four major organizations that use our fields. She stated she hasn't heard anything back from any of the organizations.
