Comprehensive Plan Update

Sheila reported that DCNR has changed the grant round to an April 13 deadline. She didn't believe they would be able to complete it in time because they haven't received the final plan from Rettew along with the other needed approvals. She stated they aren't far enough along in the process to get the grant together for this year. She stated once the plan is adopted it can't vary much without going through the whole process again. She stated she thought they should use 2007 to plan and collect all the information needed to try for a grant in 2008. Discussion followed regarding what or if anything could be done this year.

Fireworks Tent

Sheila stated they are asking for June 26 through July 5, 2007 and have supplied all the information needed. The Board decided they would like to keep the fee

at \$300 which was the charge last year.

Sanis Ultra-Clean

Sheila stated she had received information from this company regarding sanitizing restrooms at the parks. She stated there was nothing in the budget for this year but it was something the Board could consider for next year if they thought it was needed.

Map for Memorials

Sheila showed the map Clayton Snyder had completed for the memorials at Lion's Lake. The Board agreed he had done an excellent job on the map.
