

**MINUTES
NORTH LEBANON TOWNSHIP
PARKS & RECREATION BOARD
April 3, 2007**

The meeting of the North Lebanon Township Parks & Recreation Board was called to order at 7:00 PM at the North Lebanon Township Municipal Building located at 725 Kimmerlings Road, North Lebanon Township. The meeting started with the pledge to the flag.

MOTION: Motion was made and seconded to approve the March minutes. Motion unanimously approved.

COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

There were no comments from the public.

NEW BUSINESS

Comprehensive Plan Update

Sheila reported she had not received any comments yet from DCNR. She stated they said they would be getting in touch with her by the end of the week.

Fees In Lieu Of Update

Sheila stated she had supplied the Board with a new fees in lieu of report update which included Homestead Acres Phase IV, Arnold Acres lot addition, Brusters Ice Cream, and a subdivision Seyfert lot addition off of Grubb Avenue for a total of approximately \$50,000.

Softball Tournament

Sheila had received a request from Randy Wise from Lions Lake/Ebenezer Softball to use the Lions Lake field, pavilion and Old Ebenezer Softball field for

a tournament over the weekend of August 10, 11, and 12th. She stated she emailed him with some questions and comments. She said he hadn't replied. She stated she wanted to ask the Board regarding the use of the pavilion. The suggestion from the Board was that they would like to know how many people and teams would participate, exact hours, if these are primary or secondary fields, number of games, and cleaning up trash. Sheila stated she would contact him again.

Humane Society of Lebanon County

She stated she had received a request from the Humane Society of Lebanon County to use Lions Lake for a fundraiser on Sunday, May 6th. They are asking to use the snack bar area and one of the picnic areas. She stated they would like to have a dog picnic where they will bring their leashed dogs for a picnic, have food for sale for owners and guests, raffles, recreational and educational activities. Animal rescue will be there to educate the public along with other animal related organizations. They said they will be responsible for all clean up. They stated all proceeds would be donated to a new fund that will be used for emergency cases regarding stray animals and people who are unable to care for their pets due to financial difficulties. Sheila stated she would contact them to get clarification of their requests.

OLD BUSINESS

Fireworks Tent and Fruit Stand

Sheila stated they had not received payment for the fireworks tent yet. They also did not receive a reply from the people who had requested the fruit stand at Lion's Lake.

Pertinent Issues

There were no pertinent issues regarding old business.

Comments from the Public

Charles Allwein, a township resident, commented on an issue which was discussed at the Board of Supervisors meeting the previous evening regarding the Union Canal Park. The suggestion at the Board of Supervisor's meeting was that the Parks and Recreation Board use a portion of their fees in lieu of funds for paving of additional parking at the Union Canal Park which is run by the

Friends of Union Canal Park but is located within the Township. Sheila stated she would like to have additional time to get more information and also the Parks and Recreation Board does not have any additional funds to work with beyond the fees in lieu of fund for their own projects.

With there being no more business brought before the Park and Recreation Board the meeting was adjourned at 7:45 P.M.
