

**MINUTES
NORTH LEBANON TOWNSHIP
PARKS & RECREATION BOARD
June 1, 2010**

NEW BUSINESS

Sheila reported they had completed the park inspection. She stated they inspected all the parks and had found some broken "s" hooks on the chain at New Covenant. She said safety wise everything looked good at the parks. She explained they now have light activated doors and they may get some money back from Met-Ed for energy saving devices. She mentioned there was one outlet which was not attached to anything at Long Lane and in the one bathroom at Lions Lake the sink was just hanging but has since been removed. She stated they had some new benches to replace the rickety ones which have not been installed yet. She said for the most part the parks looked good.

There were no pertinent issues under new business.

OLD BUSINESS

Lake Inspection

Sheila stated she had received a phone call from a company that might be interested in doing the inspection of the dam at Lion's Lake at the cost of \$2,100 for the first four hours and after that for \$425 an hour. Sheila stated this company may be in the area in June or July and she would like to have some direction from the Board as to how they would like to proceed. There is \$2,900 in the 2010 approved budget to do this job. Discussion followed regarding what was being requested by DEP for the inspection.

MOTION: Motion was made and seconded to go ahead with the contract with this company. With no further discussion motion carried.

Pertinent Issues

Sheila stated she had no pertinent issues. Question was asked what the cost was for the new playground equipment? Sheila replied she would update the Board when she has received all the receipts.

With there being no more business brought before the Parks and Recreation Board the meeting was adjourned at 7:15 P.M.
