

**MINUTES

The meeting of the North Lebanon Township Parks & Recreation Board was called to order at 7:00 PM at the North Lebanon Township Municipal Building located at 725 Kimmerlings Road, North Lebanon Township. The meeting started with the pledge to the flag.

**NEW BUSINESS**

**FILO Update**

Sheila stated about the only things they have been spending money on are playground and energy saving items. She further said they are slowly getting through plan approval for the new park. She said they spent \$12,932.28 on the playground which was not just the structures but various other expenses like concrete, permits, tools, etc. She explained the playground equipment was \$9,918. She said they have not received any new money because construction has been slow but hopefully Phase I of the Crossings at Sweet Briar will soon provide some funding. She mentioned the loan had been paid off.

**Storm Damage**

Chairperson Snavely mentioned there had been storm damage at the Lake. Sheila stated a tree had fallen on one of the fences, the flag pole had bent, and here at the Township Park at one of the dugouts the roof and the flashing rolled up. She explained the adjustor had been there but she had not had a chance to speak with Dave.

Sheila stated we had received a phone call from a person who said she slipped and fell in one of the bathrooms at Lions' Lake. The person stated the accident had occurred after the storm had passed through late Thursday afternoon. The call came in on Friday after the storm with the person stating she had missed a day of work. Sheila mentioned the incident occurred in the bathroom which had the non-slip floor. She stated the insurance company was notified as soon as she returned to the office. Sheila didn't have any further information from the insurance company at this time.

**Batting Cages**

She said someone had contacted Dave regarding the batting cages in the vicinity where we will be placing our pavilion because they were not in good repair. Sheila stated she would like the opinion of the Board regarding these batting cages.

**MOTION: Motion was made and seconded that if the batting cages are an eye sore or a safety issue that they be taken down. Motion carried.**

**Pertinent Issues**

Member Elder stated he had seen kids on the roof of the dugouts on the Teener Field at Long Lane and suggested placing signs on the dugouts. He was concerned about the liability to the Township. Sheila stated she would check into what the options would be.

Sheila stated she had contacted the individual they had approved at the last meeting but he wasn't sure the camera would fit into the pipe because of its size. She said she re-contacted him several times with no reply from him.
