

**MINUTES
NORTH LEBANON TOWNSHIP
PARKS & RECREATION BOARD
September 7, 2010**

The meeting of the North Lebanon Township Parks & Recreation Board was called to order at 7:00 PM at the North Lebanon Township Municipal Building located at 725 Kimmerlings Road, North Lebanon Township. The meeting started with the pledge to the flag.

MOTION: Motion was made and seconded to approve the July minutes as the August meeting was cancelled. Motion carried.

COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

There were no comments from the public until the latter part of the meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

Fireworks Tent

Sheila stated a request has been made by the fireworks company once again for setting up a tent from June 27 through July 5, 2011. Chairperson Snavelly asked if the cost of \$300 would be acceptable again next year.

MOTION: Motion was made and seconded to approve them renting the space again for 2011 for \$300. Motion carried.

Incident at bathroom at Long Lane Field

Sheila stated Dave was required to clean up the mess in the men's room near the concession stand. Question was asked about locking the restroom. Discussion followed regarding the possibility of locking the restrooms after dark. Sheila stated there were always problems from time to time with the restrooms mostly at Lions' Lake.

Storm Damage Update

Sheila stated they had received the check for the flagpole and the fence. She explained the dugout had not yet been repaired. She mentioned there was a deductible on the insurance therefore we would need to provide the labor and supplies on our own.

Lake Inspection Update

Sheila stated she had been in contact with the Liquid Engineering Group and they replied we would be on the agenda for the fall. She explained she signed the paperwork and they said they would give about a week's notice before they began.

Pertinent Issues

DCNR Grant

Sheila said she was told they were hoping for September or October. She stated she is waiting for approval of the land development plan.

Township News article

Sheila stated in the new copy of the Township News there is an article about how to naturalize your parks which supports the focus of going green including use of native plants, managing ground and storm water, streamside and wetland buffers, trees, and wildlife. She commented the article mentioned the concept of not manicuring the recreation areas. Discussion followed regarding this matter. Sheila mentioned that erosion continues to be an issue at the Lake.

Sports Agreements

Chairperson Snavelly said it was about time to start looking at the contracts for next year to see if there are any changes from last year to look at incorporating. Discussion followed regarding the different groups involved.

Comments from the public

A member of the Ebenezer Football Association stated their keys did not work on the door by the concession stand. The representative stated they were to share the concession stand with baseball. The representative stated they would need the key for that door by the next Tuesday because she stated the supplies had

been ordered. Sheila replied she would check into it with Dave and contact the president of the organization regarding the issue of the keys.
