

**MINUTES

NEW BUSINESS

Pertinent Issues

Sheila mentioned they had finally received the land development plan from Rettew to be sent to the County and hopefully there will be little or no review comments and this can be completed. The plan has been out since 2008. Sheila further stated she had heard nothing from DCNR yet. Question was asked how the land development plan worked and what they would be looking at to which she explained it needs to be approved similar to a standard development plan. She further explained the primary issues the County would look at are erosion and storm water. She stated basically this plan included Phase I of the Leni Lenape Park.

OLD BUSINESS

Lake Inspection

Sheila stated they were on the list to have the inspection completed sometime in October.

Sports Agreements/Keys

Sheila reported that the sports keys were not re-keyed as originally requested. She said it was agreed upon between the football and baseball organizations to swap keys so they would have access to the door by the concession they requested. She explained she will be sending out a letter asking for the return of all the keys and also a new agreement for next year.

Pertinent Issues

Chairperson Snavelly stated she had received the information Sheila sent regarding green parks. Sheila replied the proposal for the new park is compliant with green space.

Budget

Sheila explained they had not yet started on the 2011 budget. They are going to try building an open air pavilion by year end to use the fees in lieu of for the Western District that was budgeted for 2010. Sheila stated she was hoping she would have information regarding funds from the County which ties in with the DCNR funding. Hopefully by next month we will have word from DCNR. She stated Dave would like to have some abloy keys made for the overhead garage doors at Long Lane and he would also like to replace some of the dead trees at Lions' Lake. Discussion followed regarding the trees.

With there being no more business brought before the Parks and Recreation Board the meeting was adjourned at 7:20 P.M.
