

**MINUTES

**NEW BUSINESS**

**Comprehensive Plan Discussion**

Lauren from Rettew handed out copies of the comprehensive plan with the changes included. She stated the sketch for the Leni Lenape Park which had been revised to reflect the changes the Board requested from the last meeting. This included ski and sledding trails, low impact walking trails, learning centers, sports fields, and different types of lighting. She stated they also included a nine-hole Frisbee golf course, entrance and kiosk signs, and maintenance shed. Sheila mentioned the tree dedication was popular at Lion's Lake and whether this would be a possibility at this park. Discussion regarding layout of the golf course, landscaping along the properties of residents bordering the park, and lighting placement followed. Sheila stated this plan has a nice balance without too much disturbance of the natural layout of the land.

Mr. Brinser stated that Rettew would bring the final plans and cost estimates to the next meeting. Discussion of some aspects of the plan followed.

Sheila asked if anyone had any questions regarding the meeting dates for next year.

**Grant Request**

Sheila stated they had applied for a Growing Greener grant and would update the Board at the next meeting regarding the outcome.
