

## RECREATIONAL BURNING



Outdoor fires are permitted for recreational purposes within the Twp. upon the issuance of a permit from the Police Department.

This permit is free.

1. An application is made to the Twp. indicating the person and/or organization responsible for the burning.
2. The designated place for fire shall be at least 30 feet from any building or structure.
3. The fire shall be attended at all times by the responsible applicant or individual under the applicant's direction or control.

## WHEN A BURN BAN IS PUT INTO PLACE.

When extremely dry conditions are present due to lack of rain, the Lebanon County Commissioners or NLT Board of Supervisors may issue a burn ban until said time conditions are more favorable for burning.



## FINES

Residents who are burning illegally may be fined up to \$1000. Report any illegal burning activities to the NLT Police Department.

In North Lebanon Township the regulations for burning are as follows:



1. Containers must be non-combustible & covered with a 1/4" screen.
2. Fires must be 30 feet from any structure.
3. Burning must be done between the hours of 7a.m. and sunset.

New Year's Day  
Memorial Day  
July 4th  
Labor Day  
Thanksgiving Day  
Christmas Day



## WHAT YOU CAN BURN!!!

1. Scrap paper, such as paper towels, plates, napkins, and tissues.
2. Paper Board such as soda cartons, cereal and pasta boxes.
3. No burning of recyclables (including brush & leaves) or construction materials allowed!
