**NEW BUSINESS**

**Replacement ball field status**

Sheila reported that last month they had briefly discussed the replacement of the ball field which will be used for the expansion of the Yardwaste facility. She explained that the design of the facility expansion will eliminate Ball Field #1 (as shown in the GIS photo). She reported they met with the engineer and walked around the whole township facility to see where they could put another field. She mentioned there had been some drainage problems and stormwater issues in the lower end around 7<sup>th</sup> Street. She said they had not come up with anything concrete but the engineers would like to have a design to share with the Parks and Recreation Board and the Board of Supervisors by the next meeting.

She showed the layout of the area and where there may be a possibility for the replacement field on the township property. She explained there is talk of some

extra parking. Dwayne described some of the possibilities he had been involved with in the past. Discussion followed regarding the potential areas for the field and some of the issues with the parking. There was discussion regarding the possible costs which may be involved.

**Pertinent Issues**

Sheila had some information to show the Board regarding the disk golf. She mentioned in the article she had read it mentioned the possibility of recruiting sponsors for the various golf holes.

**OLD BUSINESS**

**Park Update**

Sheila reported they had finally received the sign for the new park. She showed the Board pictures of the sign, the pavilion with the restroom, and some of the walking trails. She explained they had all of the playground equipment stored in our pavilion. She mentioned the playground equipment is very bright and colorful.

She reported Dave has been very busy getting the ball fields ready and will need to get the pavilions ready for rentals. Discussion followed the possibility of vandalism at the new pavilion.

Sheila reported she had received communication from New Covenant regarding the ongoing issues of field use.

Sheila reported she had finally received a copy of the hazmat report for the paint spill. She explained that the engineer had given them a suggestion for a treatment for the dam at Lions Lake where there is a spalling problem with the concrete chipping away. She said the material had just shown up that day but Dave has not had time to try it yet. She would like to go out to the site when he is able to try the treatment. Question was asked when the seasonal personnel will start to which Sheila thought it may be in about two weeks.
